For me his wounds shall plead

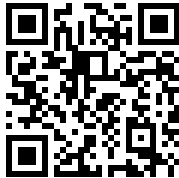
I Need No Other

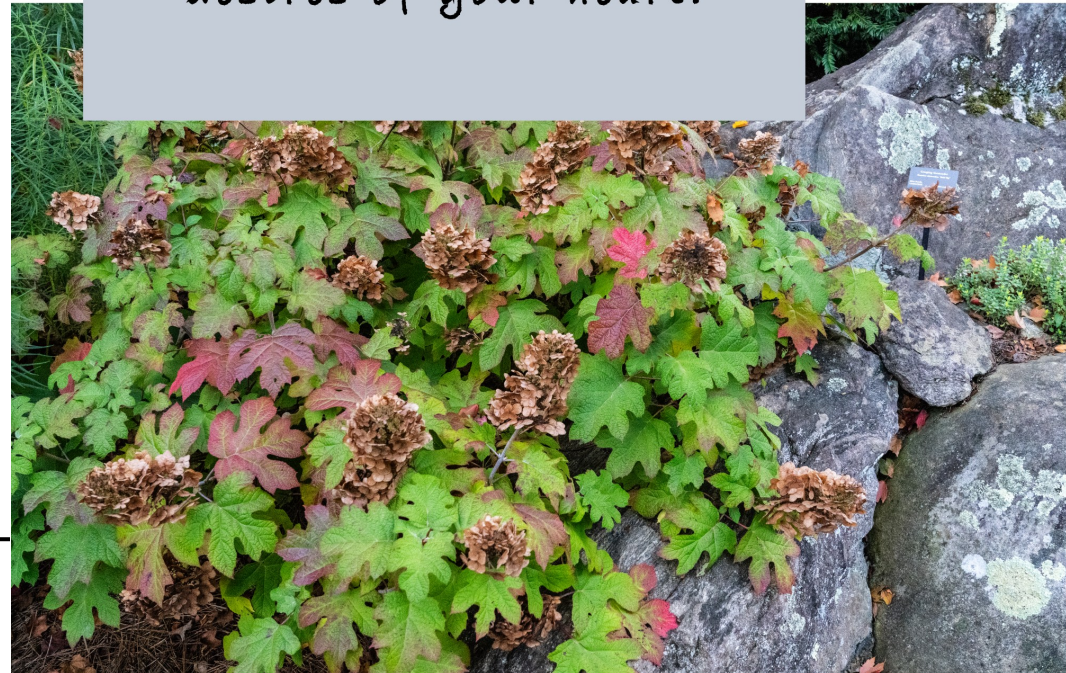
